The Weymouth and Portland National Sailing Academy is a world class sailing venue based on the Isle of Portland in Dorset, UK. The location provides easy access to Portland Harbour and Weymouth Bay, arguably some of the best sailing waters in the world. This was born out by being selected as the venue for sailing competition at the London 2012 Olympic Games and Paralympic Games.

The Not for Profit business is located on the beautiful World Heritage site of the Jurassic Coast in Dorset and with more than 8,000 visitors a year WPNSA generates a significant income to the local economy with the competitors attending the sailing events using local accommodation, restaurants etc.

Registration will run early from 8:00 - 10:30 on Saturday Morning in Spinnakers Restaurant upstairs in the Sailing Academy.

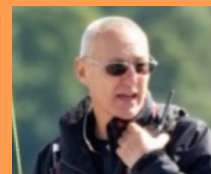

We would love to see as many parents as possible for a great opportunity to meet other parents, put names to faces and find answers to any questions you need to know, but daren't ask when the teenagers are around!

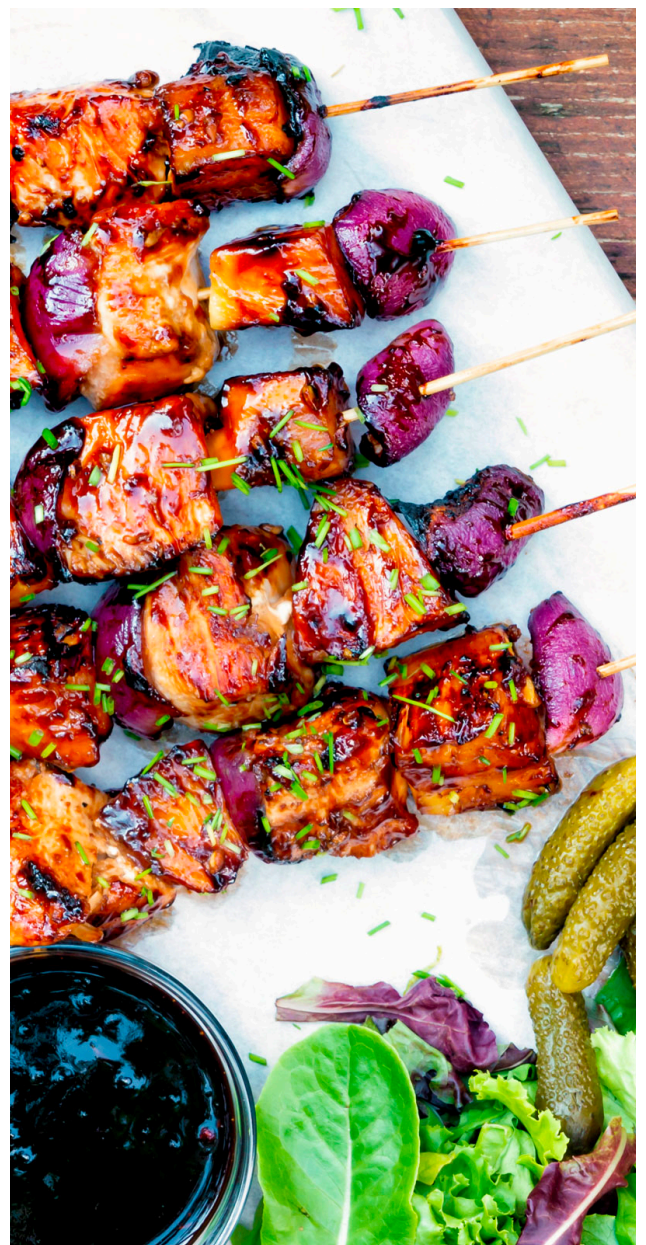




All competitors and supporters are welcome to a BBQ from 6.00pm on Monday 24th July on the balcony at Weymouth and Portland National Sailing Academy.

BBQ Tickets will be available to purchase in advance from [29er.org.uk](http://29er.org.uk) with a limited number available during registration.

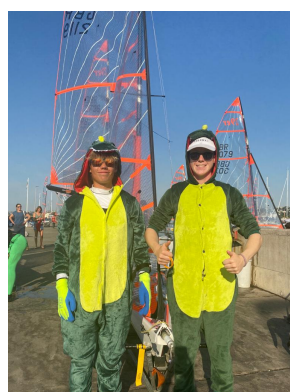
Following the BBQ all are encouraged to stay for the UK Class association AGM
