Supplementary Sailing Instructions

The Organising Authority is the Welsh National Sailing Academy and Events Centre in conjunction with the UK 29er Class Association.

These instructions should be read in conjunction with the UK 29er Class Association Major Event Instructions 2023/24 (MEIs) and Notice of Race GP series 2023 Paragraph numbers below refer to paragraph numbers in the MEIs, where applicable.

2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

- 2.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the [official notice board](#).

4 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 4.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the flagpole located to the west of Plas Heli the Welsh National Sailing Academy and Events Centre.

6 SCHEDULE

- 6.1 Registration will be in Room 2 just inside the hanger adjacent to the roller shutter door from 09:00 to 10:30 on Saturday 14th October 2023.
- 6.2 The competitor briefing will be on the grass slope between the club and the dinghy park (although in the case of adverse weather it will be moved to the hanger at 10:30 on Saturday 14th October 2023).

8 RACE AREA

- 8.1 The race area is in the waters of Cardigan Bay.

9 AREAS OF OBSTRUCTION

- 9.1 The wall for the marina approach is rock armour, which is submerged at high tide. The end is a rock armour cone which is always visible with a starboard top mark. Competitors must leave this to starboard leaving the beach and port on returning to the beach.

12 MARKS

- 12.1 Marks 1, 1a, 2s & 2p will be red inflatable marks.

12.2

- 12.3 When the next leg of the course is changed and signalled as described in RRS 33, the race committee will lay a new mark, which will be a blue dumpy inflatable mark and remove the original mark as soon as possible.

22 TALLIES

- 22.1 Tallies will be used.
- 22.2 The tally control point will be at the top of the ramp to the beach. Tallies comprise of numbered rubber wristbands. Numbers will be allocated at registration. Tallies shall be worn visibly, over clothing, on the right wrist by sailors at all times while afloat.

24 OFFICIAL AND SUPPORT BOATS

- 24.1 All visiting RIBs need to register with the club and pay a £40 licence fee. The club will then arrange with the Harbour Marine for launching (for which there is an additional fee).
- 24.2 There is a 4-knot speed limit from the marina to the mouth of the river.
