SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SSI's)

The Organising Authority is Warsash Sailing Club (WSC) in conjunction with the UK 29er Class Association.

These instructions should be read in conjunction with the UK 29er Class Association Major Event Instructions 2024/25 (MEIs) and the Notice of Race GP series 2024/25.

Paragraph numbers below refer to paragraph numbers in the MEIs, where applicable.

4. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the Official Notice Board.

Communication channels: In addition to the Official Notice Board, the Organising Authority may send messages to competitors and support persons via the Instant Messaging Application, Telegram. Relevant links can be found in the MEIs Appendix 2

5. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

Signals made ashore will be displayed on the flag masts located on the lawn outside Shore House MEI 4.3 change: The time between D-Flag and 1st warning signal is increased to 45 minutes.

6. SCHEDULE

Registration: Competitors shall register between 09:00 – 10:30 on Saturday 22nd March

Competitors' Briefing: The competitors' briefing will take place in the main hall of Shore House clubhouse at 10:30 on Saturday 22nd March.

8. RACE AREA

The planned racing area is to the south east of the river Hamble, in the vicinity of "Williams", off Lee on Solent, this will be confirmed during the Saturday morning competitors briefing.

9. AREAS OF OBSTRUCTION

When leaving and entering Hamble river, 29ers should keep in between the channel markers at all times. To the west of the posts is a shingle bank, and to the east is shallow water. A safety briefing will be provided as part of the competitors briefing and all competitors are recommended to attend.

12. MARKS

Marks 1, 1a, 2s and 2p will be orange cylindrical marks

The change mark will be a black cylindrical mark.

22. TALLIES

Tallies will be used.

The tally control point will be confirmed at the briefing on Saturday morning.

Tally Numbers will be allocated at registration. Tallies shall be worn visibly, over clothing, on the right wrist by sailors at all times while afloat.

24. OFFICIAL AND SUPPORT BOATS

No coach boats are allowed for this event, unless approved by the Uk 29er class.
